
ORDER VACATING ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPEAL OF:

FAUN GOMEZ, Appellant,


vs.

DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY, DENVER SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT,
and the City and County of Denver, a municipal corporation, Agency.

An Order to Show Cause issued, commanding Appellant to state why his constitutional claims should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Appellant filed a timely response. The Agency was not required to respond and did not. In her response, Appellant withdrew (moved to dismiss) her constitutional claims regarding the Sheriff's Department and Career Service Rules she is charged with violating.

Accordingly, Appellant's claims of constitutional claims of due process, equal protection and general constitutionality of CSR 16-60 B., E., L and Sheriff's Dept. Orders 200.41 and 20042 are dismissed. The appeal will proceed on the remaining claims of Appellant's alleged violation of those rules cited by the Agency and the reasonableness of the selected discipline.
