

# What counts as Evidence of Community Support?

## **What types of documents can I submit?**

Evidence of community can be any of the following, as long the documentation is authorized by an officer, director, or agent of one or more eligible neighborhood organizations:

- A letter of community support or non-opposition;
- A document indicating community support or non-opposition;
- A good neighbor agreement; or
- Any other evidence of community support deemed sufficient by the director.

## **Which organizations can provide community support?**

An eligible neighborhood organization must:

- Include within its boundaries all or a portion of the property where a common consumption area is proposed to be located;
- Be a registered neighborhood organization as defined in the Denver Revised Municipal Code;
- Have been in existence for more than two years.

If no such organization exists, the director may designate an association of residents and owners of real property as an eligible neighborhood organization upon the written request of an applicant.
