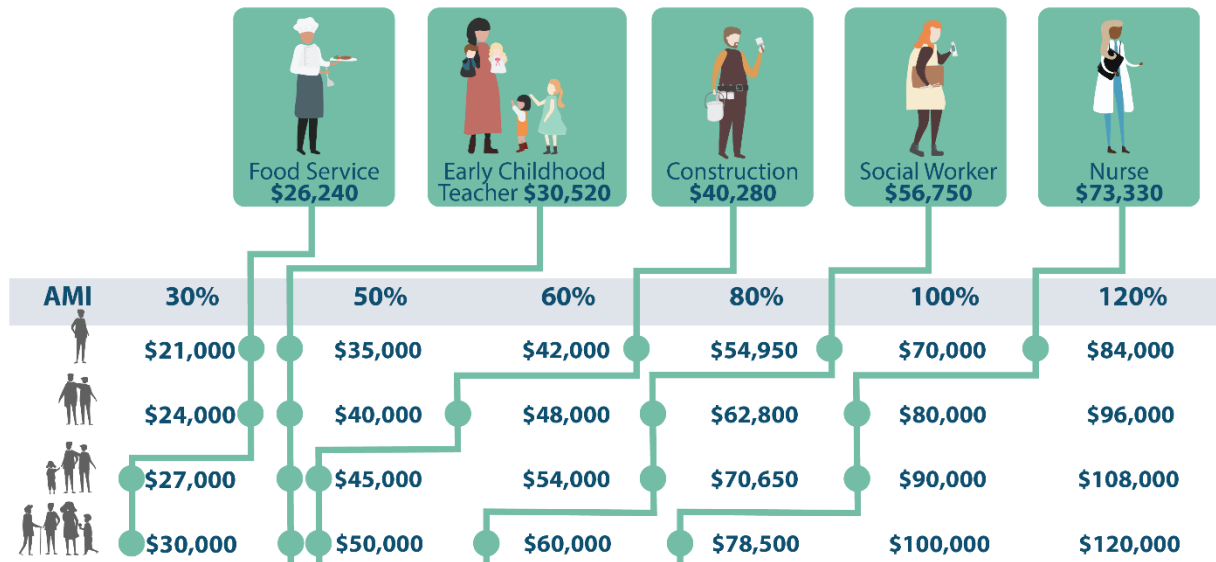


## Area Median Income and Average Salaries
