



PERMIT AMENDMENT APPLICATION

FOR ENCROACHMENTS & ENCUMBRANCES IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

If an Encroachment Permittee desires to make changes to their approved Encroachment and/or the associated Encroachment Permit, the Permittee shall first obtain an Encroachment Permit Amendment. Encroachment Permit Amendments will be approved by either Department of Transportation & Infrastructure (DOTI) or City Council in the same way the Encroachment Permit was originally approved. - Copy of Encroachment Permit, Resolution, or Annual Encroachment Permit Bill
- Permit Amendment Fees (must be paid immediately after ER provides an invoice for your application)
- Revised Permit Application materials in accordance with applicable [Encroachment Permit](#) and [Small Cell Permit](#) Application Requirements. *Examples include, but are not limited to, revised: plans, calculations, reports, location, area description, permit application with new owner information.*
