

Washington Street Study

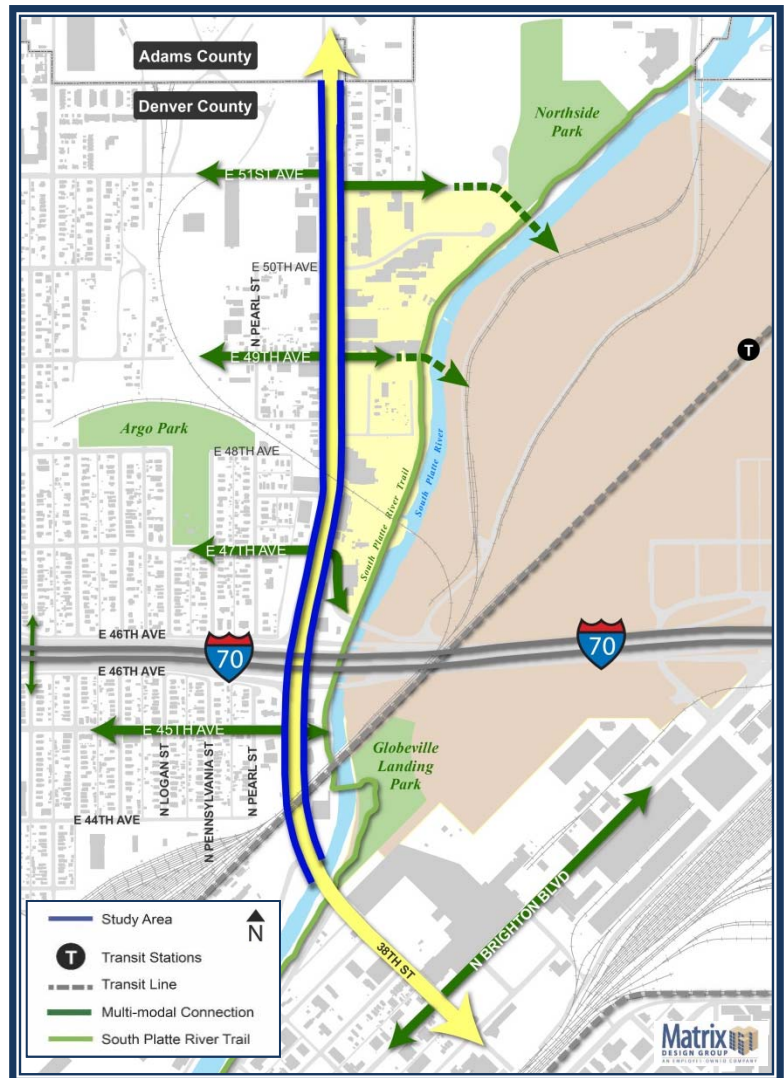
Washington Street was identified in the Globeville Neighborhood Plan as “an attractive corridor that creates a positive sense of place, attracts private reinvestment, and better accommodates all transportation modes.” The Washington Street Study will refine and progress this vision of Washington Street into an implementable conceptual design to serve resident and visitor needs.

The project is organized into three phases with public engagement opportunities included in each phase. The study is scheduled for completion in the late fall of 2017.

Phase 1 - Analysis: Craft guiding principles based on community goals and priorities

Phase 2 - Alternatives: Draft development alternatives for review and comment

Phase 3 – Preferred Alternative: Narrow down and present for discussion a preferred alternative and conceptual design that will lead to a final plan and report
