<p>I would be applying on behalf of a collaborative most likely a fee for service model and was wondering if the city would be amenable to maybe having an invoice model where some of the partners would be able to invoice the fiscal agent for services provided - is that a possible structure that we could include in our proposal?</p>	<p>The fiscal agency will contract directly with the City and will be responsible for submitting all invoicing for reimbursement. The City will provide the fiscal agency with billing templates to submit with your reimbursement request along with the required supporting documentation. Also, agencies awarded funding will be required to participate in a Contractor Training that will go into more details about the fiscal management requirements of the program.</p>
<p>Is this a REIMBURSEMENT grant?</p>	<p>Yes. We would be expecting to see all required back-up documentation. Upon award, we do host a mandatory fiscal training. You will be supported by NEST program staff as assigned liaisons and DEDO's fiscal staff are available for technical assistance throughout the program contract.</p>
<p>In the addendum there was an answer to the question around census tracts and it says that you can indicate service areas by Council District neighborhood or census track. Do we provide a map of the service area?</p>	<p>There are links in the application where you can enter zip code information and it will give you census tract, neighborhood, and Council district information. Additionally, there is a link to the city website that has those defined areas. So, if you are not sure what neighborhood your address falls into, there are maps and searchable options available.</p>
<p>Under non-profit categories, does that include Faith-Based entities.</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
<p>Are there character limits in the application?</p>	<p>The smaller text boxes do you have a character limit of 250 (i.e. where you input your basic information-name, etc.). The larger text boxes for the narrative do not have a character limit.</p>
<p>Is there any conflict of interest if we speak to developing a partnership with the Denver Police Department?</p>	<p>We do not assist with the design of your program so our evaluation will be based on what you choose to propose but we do not see a conflict in developing a partnership with the Denver Police Department.</p>
