

QUESTION	ANSWER
Can we use a fiscal sponsor of our choice that is not Colorado Non-Profit Development Center (CNDC), for example - Open Collective Foundation?	Yes.
Does the fiscal sponsorship/sponsor need to be secured by the application deadline?	Yes, as that is the entity the City will be contracting with and you would be considered a “sub-contractor” to them. We will not weigh in on who you ultimately select as your fiscal sponsor.
We are a pilot start-up so since this CDBG funding is based on a reimbursement model, do you have resources you can share with us if needed?	Yes, we would be able to share what resources we may be aware of including any non-profit lending programs.
Are there character limits in the application?	This same question was asked in an earlier Technical Q&A session and the answer is no, but when responding to the small text boxes, you will be limited to 250 characters. When are applications due?	The application portal, Zengine, will close at 4:00 p.m. MST on Monday, November 8, 2021.
Are there any budgetary requirements for the fiscal agent?	The fiscal agent can include an administrative fee in their budget request. It typically has been the 10% de minimis cost rate.
