

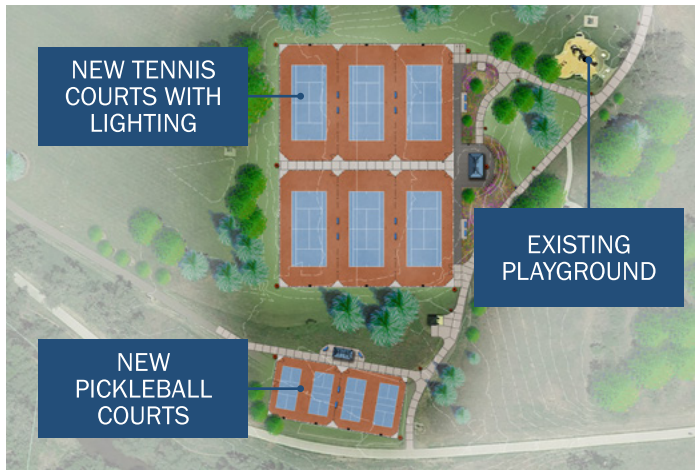

BEAR VALLEY TENNIS COURT REPLACEMENT

PROJECT BACKGROUND



Bear Valley is one of the most highly utilized tennis facilities in southwest Denver and is frequently used for league competitions. They are the only lighted courts in the area that offer year-round nighttime play. The current asphalt court surface and subsurface are too deteriorated to successfully repair, therefore, replacement is necessary.

This project will replace six existing asphalt tennis courts with post-tensioned concrete courts, which have a life span of 40 years or more. The new courts will include improved posts and netting, chain-link fencing, refurbished lighting and/or LED upgrades, and signs.

Other site improvements will include new site furnishings, shade structure, landscaping and irrigation. In response to community input, a group of pickleball courts is being added by utilizing Capital Improvement funds approved in Ballot Measure 2A.
