PROJECT BACKGROUND

One of the oldest outdoor pools in the city, the Congress Park Pool has grown costly to maintain and requires extensive upgrades. Built in 1955, the pool has seen multiple opening delays due to major leaks. The pool needs rehabilitation to accommodate the growing population and recreational trends, as well as meet modern maintenance standards.

This project includes the design and construction of a new, state-of-the-art swimming pool. The design process will include various means of gathering community input to ensure the Congress Park Pool remains a special and valued asset for the neighborhood. Local neighborhood organizations, schools and community groups were engaged throughout the design process.
