# INSPIRATION POINT PARK PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS

## PROJECT BACKGROUND

Inspiration Point Park provides stunning views of downtown to the east and the Front Range of the Rocky Mountains to the west. Built in 1910, this 25-acre park overlooking Clear Creek Valley is now surrounded by residential neighborhoods and an industrial zone.

This project includes the design and construction of a new playground, picnic area with shelter and restoration of the historic masonry wall, one of the park’s signature features. The development of a playground will provide access to play facilities for a neighborhood that currently has very few options within walking distance. This project will create new programmed uses at the park with careful integration with the historic and natural character.
