RECREATION CENTER RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Denver's recreation program includes 31 recreation centers ranging from local neighborhood centers to large regional facilities. Many of these buildings are older and have significant deferred maintenance needs.

This project will provide critical improvements to 21 recreation centers with roof replacements, HVAC replacements, fire alarm replacements, electrical upgrades, ADA improvements and other important structural repairs. Upgrades and enhancements include, lighting, floor replacement, repainting, weight room upgrades, locker room enhancements, front counter remodels, and upgrades to communications and audiovisual equipment. These measures will save taxpayer dollars, improve energy efficiency and keep recreation centers functional for years to come.
