DENVER ARTS AND VENUES IMPROVEMENTS TO RED ROCKS AMPHITHEATRE

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Red Rocks Amphitheatre is a world renowned, award-winning, naturally occurring amphitheater located just 15 miles west of Denver. As an iconic Denver landmark and concert venue, Red Rocks requires regular maintenance, rehabilitation and improvements to preserve its integrity and stay relevant with shifting industry trends and consumer expectations.

The funding provided by the Elevate Denver Bond for Red Rocks will be focused on the replacement of the current utilitarian stage roof that was constructed in the 1980s. This project will improve aesthetics with a roof that better complements the amphitheater, provides additional shelter for artists and stagehands, increases protection for instruments and improves production capabilities to add more flexibility for lighting, sound and video.
