# WASHINGTON STREET RECONSTRUCTION (47TH – 52ND AVENUES)

## PROJECT BACKGROUND

Washington Street serves as the entrance to the National Western Center, connection to I-70 and Brighton Boulevard and the 38th & Blake Station, a link to Adams County and main street to the Globeville Neighborhood. Washington Street is identified in the Globeville Neighborhood Plan as a priority transformative project, with a goal “to make Washington Street an attractive corridor that creates a positive sense of place, attracts private reinvestment and better accommodates all transportation modes.”

This project includes full roadway reconstruction of Washington Street from 47th Avenue to the City and County of Denver line at 52nd Avenue. Elements include improvements supporting pedestrian and bicycle mobility, and utility work required as a part of reconstruction. Acquisition of additional right-of-way is anticipated. The overall right-of-way and possibly the adjacent properties can be significantly improved to meet the needs of multimodal users along the corridor.
