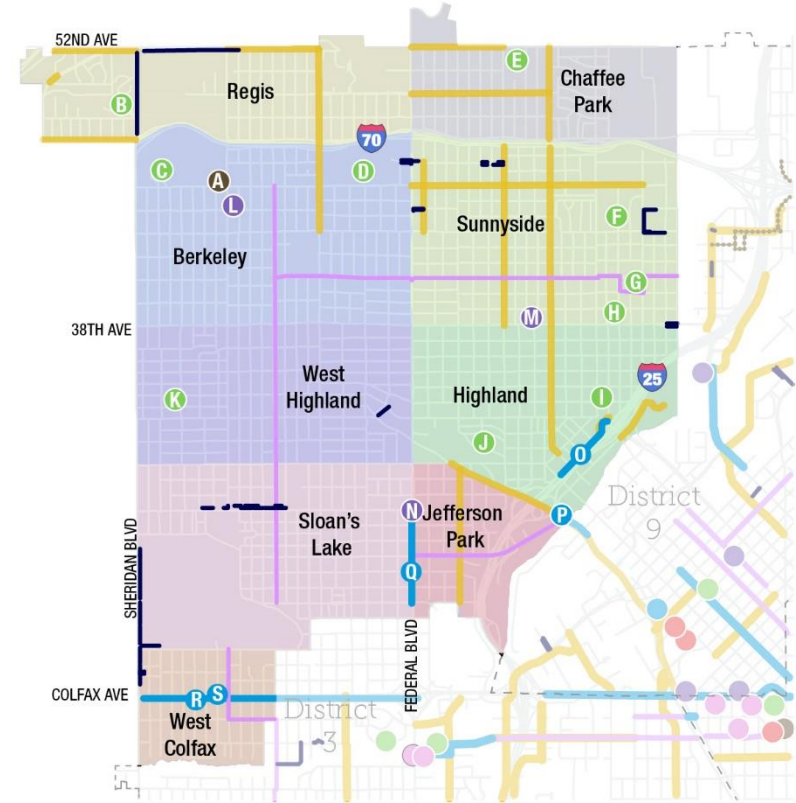

G Development	Ciancio Neighborhood Park: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete
