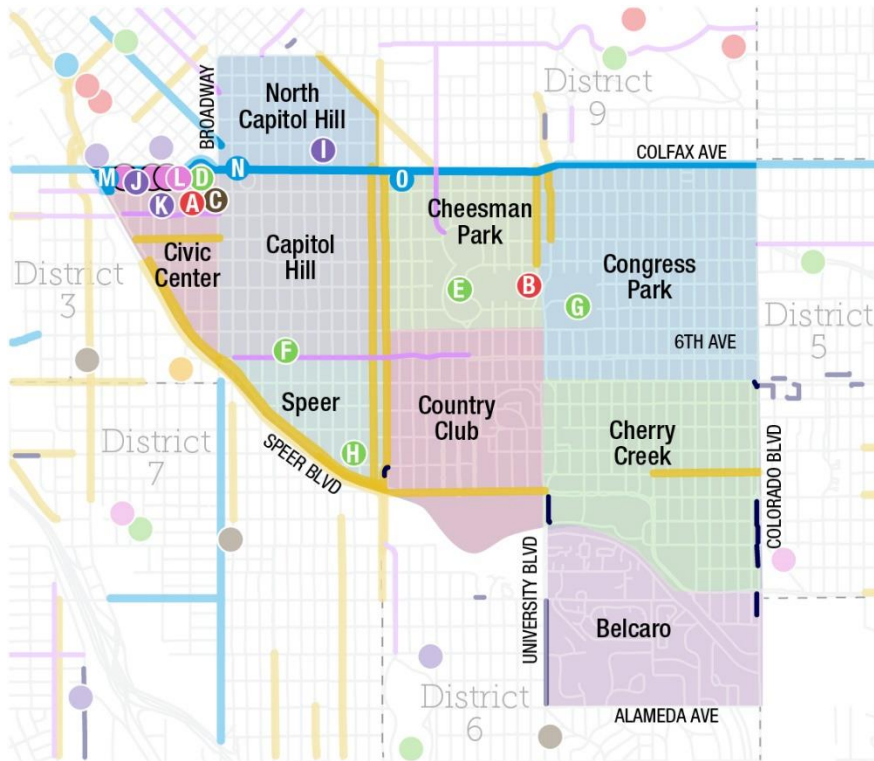


ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 10 PROJECTS

A	<i>Complete</i>	Denver Art Museum: Renovate North Building and south structure with a new Welcome Center
B	<i>Complete</i>	Denver Botanic Gardens: Construct new Science, Art and Education Center
C	<i>Construction</i>	Central Library: Address safety and security issues, deferred maintenance, and renovate space
D	<i>Design</i>	Civic Center Greek Theater: Improvements to accommodate an outdoor performance space
E	<i>Development</i>	Cheesman Park: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete and replace picnic sites
F	<i>Development</i>	Governor’s Neighborhood Park: Replace aging playground equipment
G	<i>Construction</i>	Congress Park Pool Reconstruction: Replace pool complex
G	<i>Design</i>	Congress Neighborhood Park: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete and replace picnic sites
H	<i>Development</i>	Alamo-Placita Neighborhood Park: Reconstruct basketball court and improve picnic areas
I	<i>Design</i>	Police Station District 6: Construction of a new police station to serve the community
J	<i>Design</i>	Lindsey Flanagan Courthouse: Address deferred maintenance
K	<i>Design</i>	Police Department Administration Building and Crime Lab: Address deferred maintenance
L	<i>Design</i>	City and County of Denver Building: Address deferred maintenance
M	<i>Complete</i>	14th Avenue Bridge Over Cherry Creek: Replace the bridge
N	<i>Design</i>	Colfax Bus Rapid Transit (BRT): Add exclusive bus lanes, new transit stops, and other improvements to allow the BRT to operate efficiently and effectively
O	<i>Varies</i>	Colfax Corridor Improvements: Improve pedestrian and bicycle safety
