

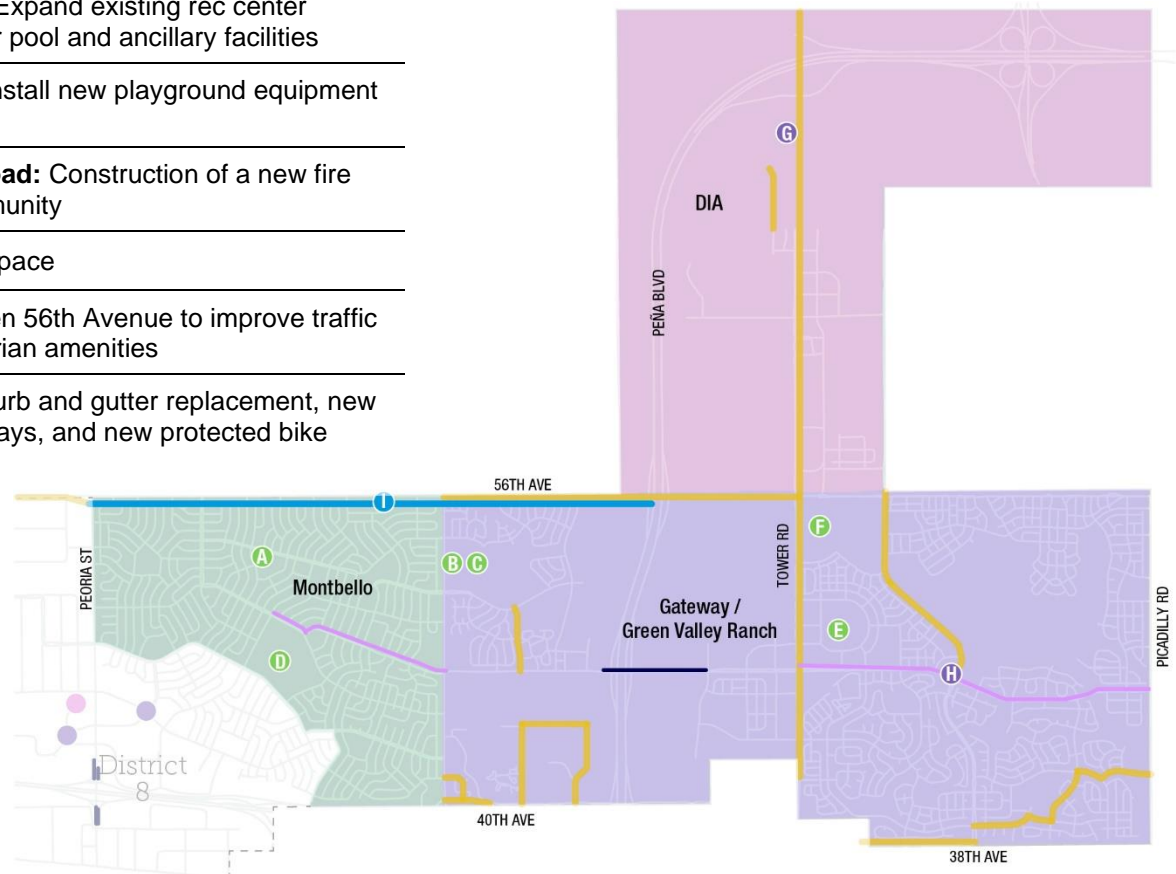
# ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 11 PROJECTS



<b>Current Status</b>	<b>Project Name and Description</b>
<b>A</b> Development	<b>Falcon Neighborhood Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete
<b>B</b> Development	<b>Parkfield Neighborhood Park:</b> Reconstruct tennis courts with post tensioned concrete
<b>C</b> Design	<b>Montbello Recreation Center:</b> Address deferred maintenance and provide upgrades
<b>D</b> Construction	<b>Montbello Central Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete and improve the picnic areas. Full replacement of aging and inefficient irrigation system
<b>E</b> Construction	<b>Green Valley Ranch Indoor Pool:</b> Expand existing rec center through construction of a new indoor pool and ancillary facilities
<b>F</b> Complete	<b>First Creek Neighborhood Park:</b> Install new playground equipment and trail connections
<b>G</b> Development	<b>Fire Station at 72nd and Tower Road:</b> Construction of a new fire station to serve the expanding community
<b>H</b> Design	<b>Fire Station 29:</b> Refurbish kitchen space
<b>I</b> Design / Construction**	<b>56th Avenue:</b> Reconstruct and widen 56th Avenue to improve traffic flow and transit, bicycle, and pedestrian amenities
See Legend	<b>Citywide projects:</b> Street paving, curb and gutter replacement, new sidewalks, new neighborhood bikeways, and new protected bike lanes
