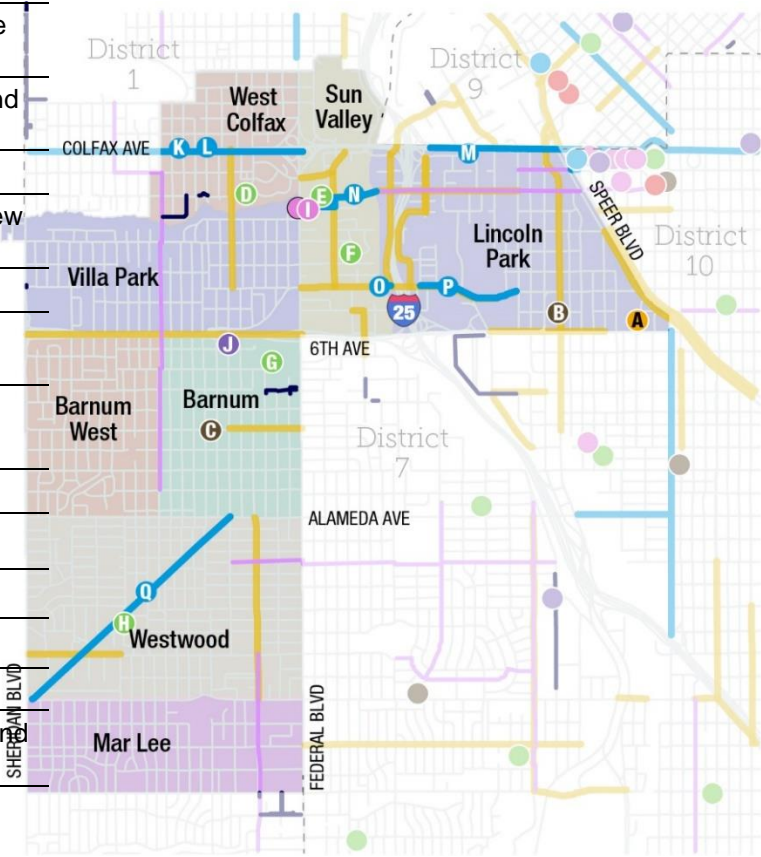


# ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 PROJECTS



Current Status	Project Name and Description
<b>A</b> Complete	<b>Denver Health:</b> Construction of an Ambulatory Care Center to be the core of the DHHA campus
<b>B</b> Complete	<b>Byers Library:</b> Refurbish architectural features, replace outdated equipment, and renovate space
<b>C</b> Design	<b>Ross Barnum Library:</b> Replace outdated equipment and renovate space
<b>D</b> Complete	<b>Paco Sanchez Re-Imagine Play Project (Phase 2):</b> Construct an innovative new play area, including outdoor venue and plaza
<b>E</b> Development	<b>Rude Recreation Center:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>F</b> Design	<b>Sun Valley Park Development:</b> Partner with SV Eco-District to create a new riverfront park including walking paths and landscaping
<b>G</b> Design	<b>Barnum Park:</b> Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete, replace the basketball courts
<b>G</b> Design	<b>Barnum Recreation Center:</b> Address recreation center deferred maintenance
<b>H</b> Design	<b>Westwood Recreation Center:</b> Construct a new recreation center
<b>I</b> Design	<b>Castro Building:</b> Address deferred maintenance
<b>J</b> Construction	<b>Fire Station 20:</b> Refurbish kitchen space
<b>K</b> Varies	<b>Colfax Corridor Improvements:</b> Improve pedestrian and bicycle safety
<b>L</b> Design	<b>West Colfax Transit Enhancements:</b> Improve transit efficiency
<b>M</b> Design	<b>Colfax Bus Rapid Transit (BRT):</b> Add exclusive bus lanes, new transit stops, and other improvements to allow the BRT to operate efficiently and effectively
<b>N</b> Construction	<b>West 13th Avenue Multimodal Reconstruction:</b> Improvements along W. 13 <sup>th</sup> Avenue, Holden Place, and Bryant Street to improve access between downtown and western neighborhoods for pedestrians, bicyclists, transit, and vehicles
<b>O</b> Construction	<b>8th Avenue Bridge Reconstruction (Over Platte):</b> Reconstruction of the bridge over South Platte River
<b>P</b> Design	<b>8th Avenue Bridge over the Railroad:</b> Rehabilitate the bridge
<b>Q</b> Design	<b>Morrison Road Improvements:</b> Full reconstruction of the 1.5 mile stretch of Morrison Road to implement the community-prepared vision
See Legend	<b>Citywide projects:</b> Street paving, curb and gutter replacement, new sidewalks, new neighborhood bikeways, new protected bike lanes, and ADA projects
