 - a. Submitted 20 expansion requests for positions 16 were approved by Mayor
 - b. Adding 5 staff to HRCP in 2022 positions to be posted in early 2022
 - i. Deputy Director
 - ii. 3 language access team members
 - iii. Financial coach
 - c. \$300,000 added to legal services fund for Immigrant & Refugee
- 4. 2 additional members to Ad Board joining the team in October
