

Denver's Mountain Parks are outside of City limits. Please review the notes below which are applicable to Mountain Park Picnic Site Permits.

Fire Bans and Restrictions

FIRE RESTRICTIONS are in effect. No open fires or charcoal grills are permitted. ONLY GAS GRILLS PERMITTED. Additional Stage 1 fire restrictions (if enacted) would restrict all open flames and use of gas grills. For current fire bans and restrictions in place, visit denvergov.org/mountainparks.

- No fires or charcoal grills are permitted
- No fires are permitted in shelter fireplaces
- No ground fires are allowed
- Only gas grills with an on/off switch or shut off may be used

The following information applies to all Mountain Park Picnic Site Permits:

- Permits are from 9am to 8pm
- Primitive pit toilets or portable toilets are provided at each location
- The use of gas grills is required. No fires and no use of wood or charcoal
- Parking is limited at many sites - please make sure parking at your picnic site works for your group size
- Surrounding meadows are not maintained as playing fields or parking areas for any picnic sites
- Water and electricity are not available at most sites unless specifically noted

Please review the special notes for the following Mountain Park Sites:

Genesee Park, Lookout Mountain Park, and O'Fallon Park picnic sites will not be available for permitting on May 31 (Memorial Day), July 4, and September 6 (Labor Day)

Newton Park (Juvenile and Stromberg)

These picnic sites will open May 9

- Entry gates will be opened or combination to locks provided (call Mountain Parks Staff for combination – 720.865.0900)
- Please lock gates upon leaving the facilities
- Surrounding meadows are not maintained as playing fields and may not be used for parking
- Existing fire pits and grills may be used unless a fire ban is in effect

O'Fallon Park

- Parking is only allowed in designated areas
- Parking is limited at this site, do not double-park
- Picnic site reservations are not available weekends
- Only gas grills with an on/off switch or shut off may be used

Red Rocks Park

On concert days the picnic shelter must be vacated by 4:00pm to accommodate event traffic

- There is limited parking near the shelter, with additional parking in parking lots below
- Everyone in your group must stay in the designated permit site or on designated hiking trails
- Climbing on rock formations is strictly prohibited. Off trail use is prohibited
- Only gas grills with an on/off switch or shut off may be used
