- Voting to replace new verbiage for Sec. 2-255.48. Legislative intent, page 2, Session 7, lines 3-6 a fixed, non-lapsing appropriation of \$3.5 million is now and always has been a TABOR Violation
 - Carol Peeples' suggestion: "The revised ordinance approved by Commissioners at the November 17, 2021, be further revised so that Section 2-255.48 (6) is replaced with "To request annual appropriations as determined by a vote of the Commissioners," and that Section 2-255.578 is replaced with "Staffing and other administrative support for the commission shall be provided by the department of safety and hiring decisions shall be made with input from the commission's officers.""
