Council district boundaries are being redrawn following the 2020 U.S. Census. City Council has been engaging with the public since September of 2021 to gather feedback on the new district boundaries.

There are two final maps in consideration:

members will vote on a final map. The new map incorporating changed district boundaries will be in effect for the 2023 municipal election.

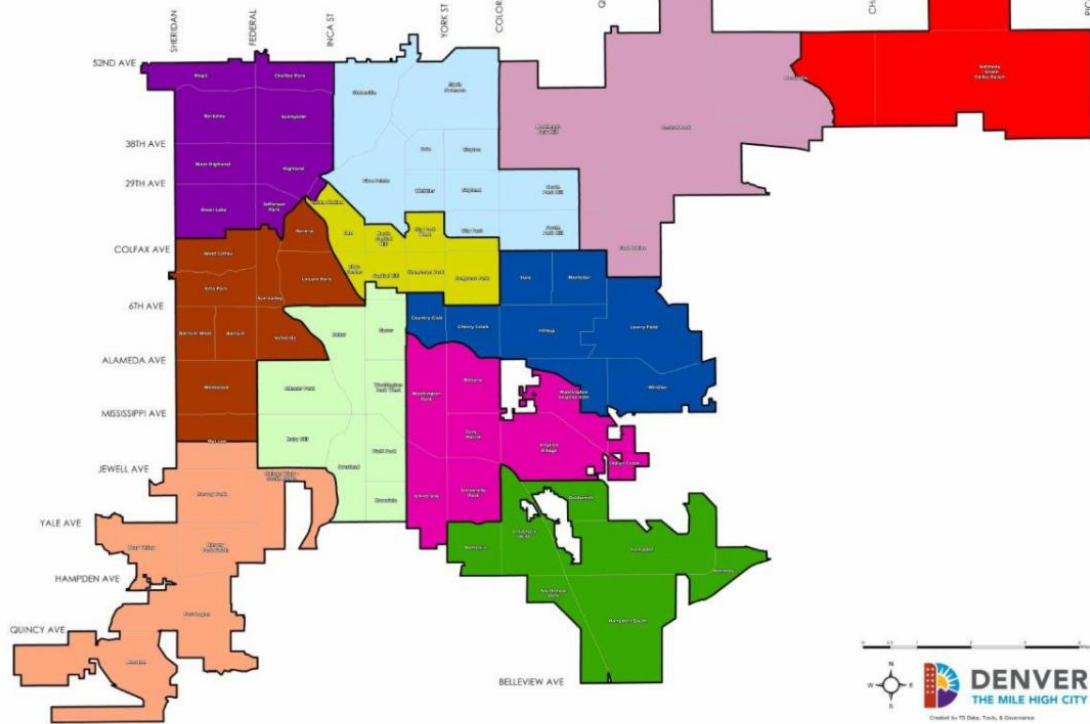

Map D - Draft 2

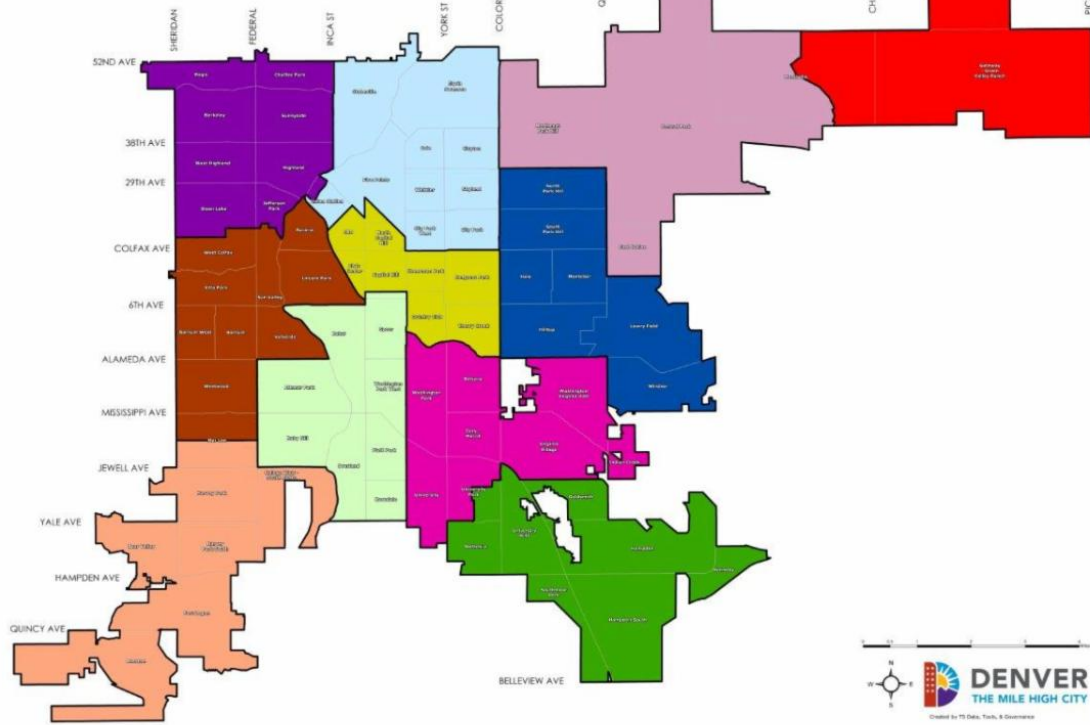
