Elections Q&A

Q: What is the legal voting age in Colorado?

You can vote once you turn 18, however, you can pre-register to vote when you turn 16.

Q: What happens if an ineligible voter attempts to vote in the election?

When voters provide their driver's license as proof of residency when they vote, our office cross-references their eligibility through a statewide system.

Q: I am living in my car, can I register to vote?

Yes, you can register to vote. Use the nearest intersection where you're staying.

Q: Can I vote if I am in jail?

If you're serving a sentence for a misdemeanor or are awaiting pre-trial sentencing, you can register to vote.
