

Electrification Feasibility Report

Pre-Site Visit Checklist

The following checklist items are divided into Must Have and Nice to have sections, the must have items are those that will be required in order to effectively complete an EFR study and should be addressed prior to the site visit or before beginning the EFR study. The nice to have items are those that will benefit the EFR process as well as benefit any facilitation assistance provided to you following EFR study, but they are not required items.

Must Have Items

- Total building square footage and square feet estimate of the area being served by the piece of equipment being replaced.
- Access to mechanical system spaces for equipment being replaced, this may include roof and basement access as well as any relevant mechanical rooms.
- Access to electrical rooms
- If access is not permitted into a space where the equipment you would like to replace is located (i.e., apartment) we need details for the equipment serving that space, equipment nameplate information is best. This includes domestic hot water heating systems as well as space heating and cooling systems.
- Gas and electric rate structure as identified on your utility gas and electric bill.

Nice to Have Items

- Building floor plans
- Facility MEP drawings and mechanical schedules
- Electric service breaker capacity and an understanding of circuit capacities serving specific equipment being evaluated for replacement.
- An understanding of existing electrical service capacity
