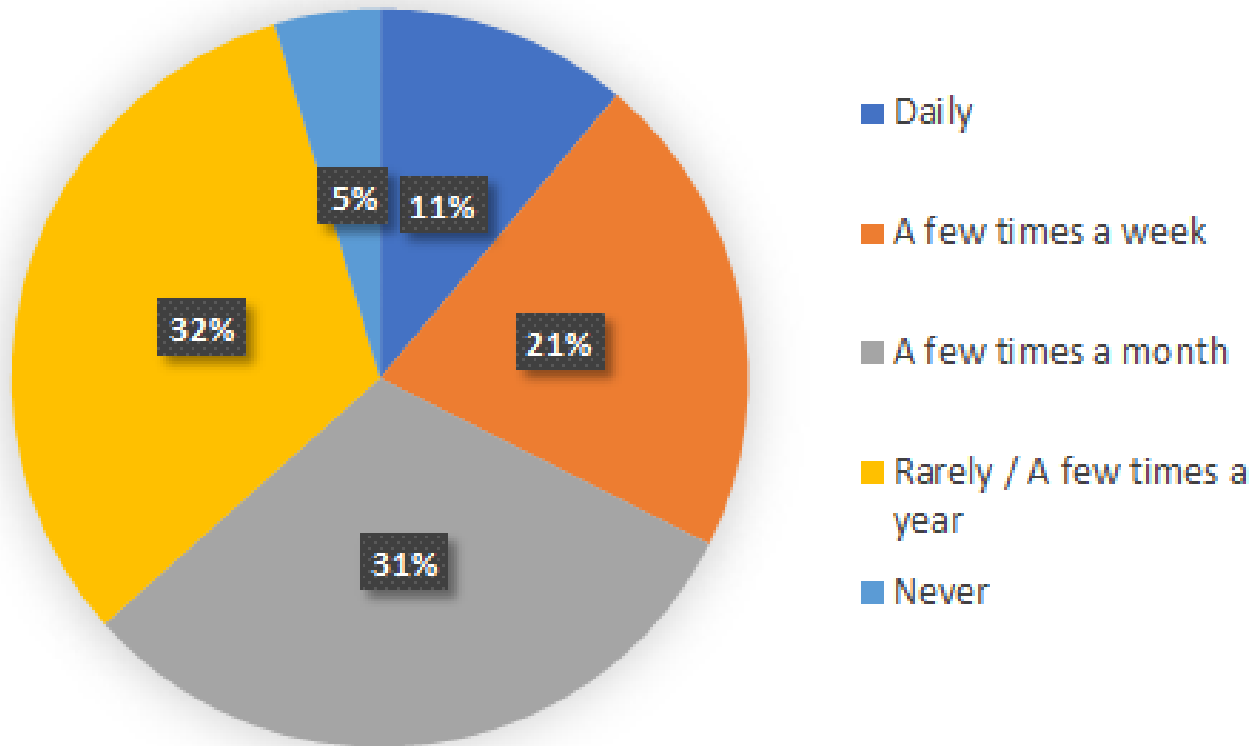

Public Feedback Highlights

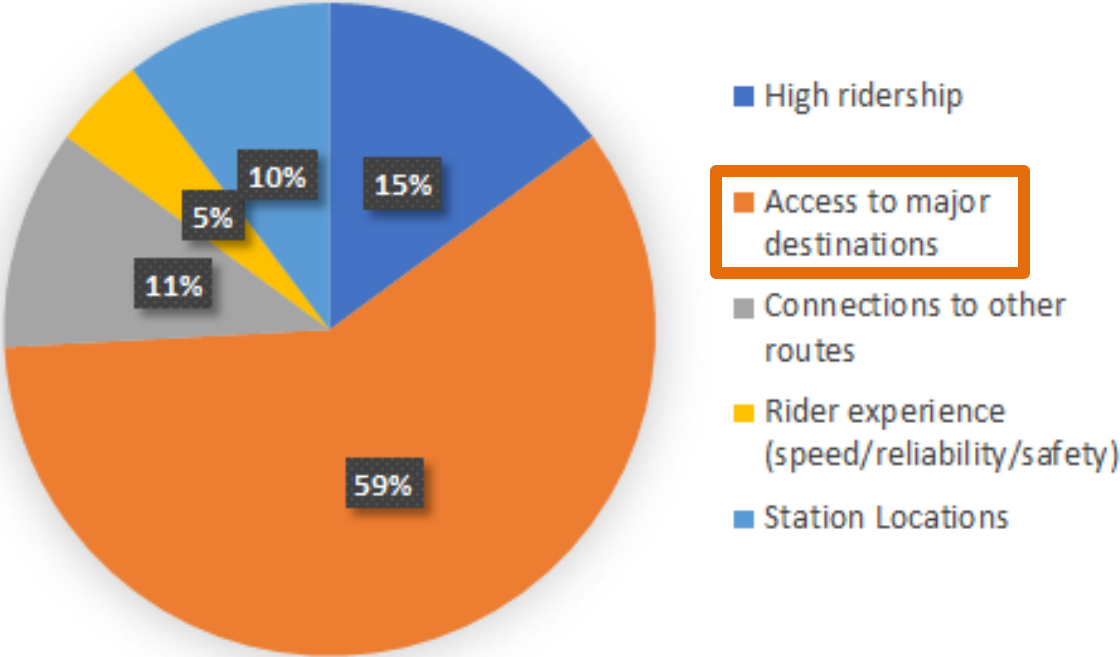
How often do you use public transit?



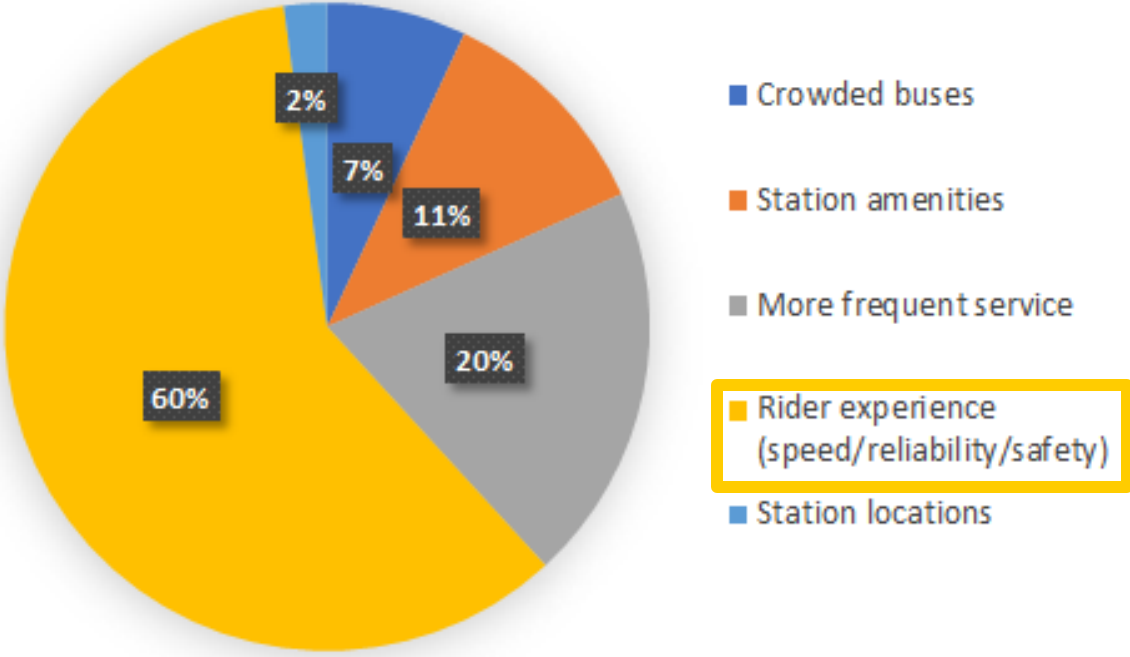
- 216 responses from 28 different zip codes
- 80% of respondents between ages 25-44
- Current public transit use varies widely among respondents
 - 32% - A few times a week or daily
 - 31% - A few times a month
 - 32% - Rarely/A few times a year
 - 5% - Never

Love

- **Strong support for local businesses** (cafes/restaurants/shops/theatres) with emphasis between Josephine and Madison stations
- **Support for existing bike lanes and pedestrian improvements;** Syracuse/Pennsylvania/Josephine/Fillmore intersections
- **Proximity to amenities and services;** current bus service and connections

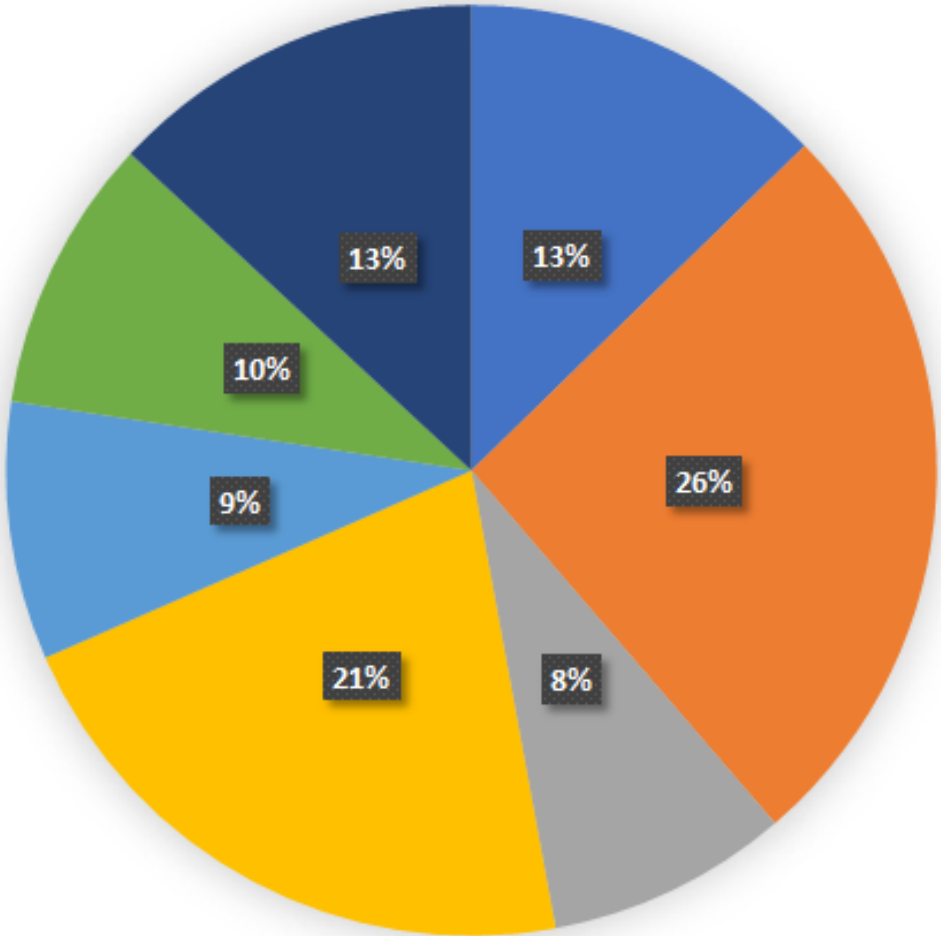


One Place I
Would
Improve

- **Desire to improve traffic flow, especially pedestrian and cyclist safety in many locations;** Civic Center/Colorado/Downing/Franklin intersections
- **Strong interest in streetscaping – enhanced lighting, improved bus shelters and placemaking elements;** Krameria/Monaco/Syracuse stations
- **Some locations identified as good opportunities for increased density and activation;** Krameria/East of Quebec

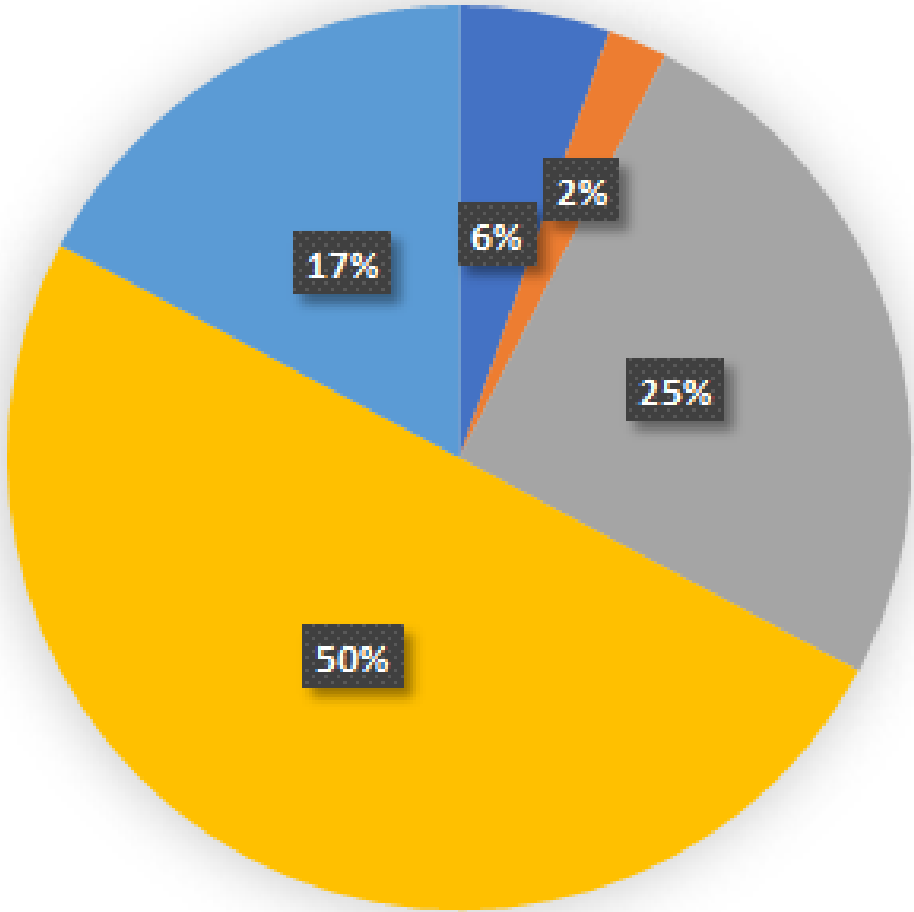

■ Making sure the project implementation meets community expectations when construction begins
