



## HAMPDEN BRANCH LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION

### PROJECT BACKGROUND

Since its original construction in 1975 and renovation in 2010, the Hampden Branch Library has seen significant growth and demand in computer use, programming, resources and staff. This project will address these capacity challenges and add 4,000 square feet to the library, allowing community spaces for programming and meetings, public computing, additional collections, an expanded maker space and dedicated teen area.
