**MEMORANDUM OF ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL WITH PREJUDICE**

On February 21, 2007, I directed the Appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for his failure to file a pre-hearing statement, and for his failure to file a time request for an extension in which to do so.

In response, the Appellant filed two letters, on February 26 and 28, neither of which stated cause to vacate my Order to Show Cause. Nonetheless, because the letters were not sufficiently clear, I set a hearing for March 8, 2007 to give this *pro se* Appellant an opportunity to bring additional documentation or provide additional explanation that might show good cause. On March 8, the Appellant appeared *pro se*. During the hearing Mr. Ed Bagwell, a Teamster's Union Representative, joined the hearing to assist the Appellant, but did not enter his appearance as the Appellant's representative. Robert A. Wolf, Assistant City Attorney attended as the Agency's representative.

The Appellant did not present any additional documents or provide any additional explanation that showed cause to vacate my Order to Show Cause. The Appellant asked for additional time to obtain further documentation. I denied that request. Because the Appellant failed to show good cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for his failure to file a timely pre-hearing statement, I Ordered this appeal DIMSSED WITH PREJUDICE.
