Brief project description

The Game Plan for a Healthy City tasks Denver Parks with using “Every Drop” to make our park system more resilient and environmentally sustainable. This project will update the Landscape Typology Manual and geodatabase to cover all parks not previously mapped and inventoried. This project will also set up a five-year strategic implementation plan to create a “Uniquely Denver” park and greenway aesthetic that will “Adapt” to the changing climate and limited resources.

Denver Parks’ goal is to create “climate resilient” parks. These are publicly accessible parks or park-like spaces that accommodate active and passive recreational activities while being able to withstand and adapt to the changing climate conditions including drought, flooding, fire, etc.
