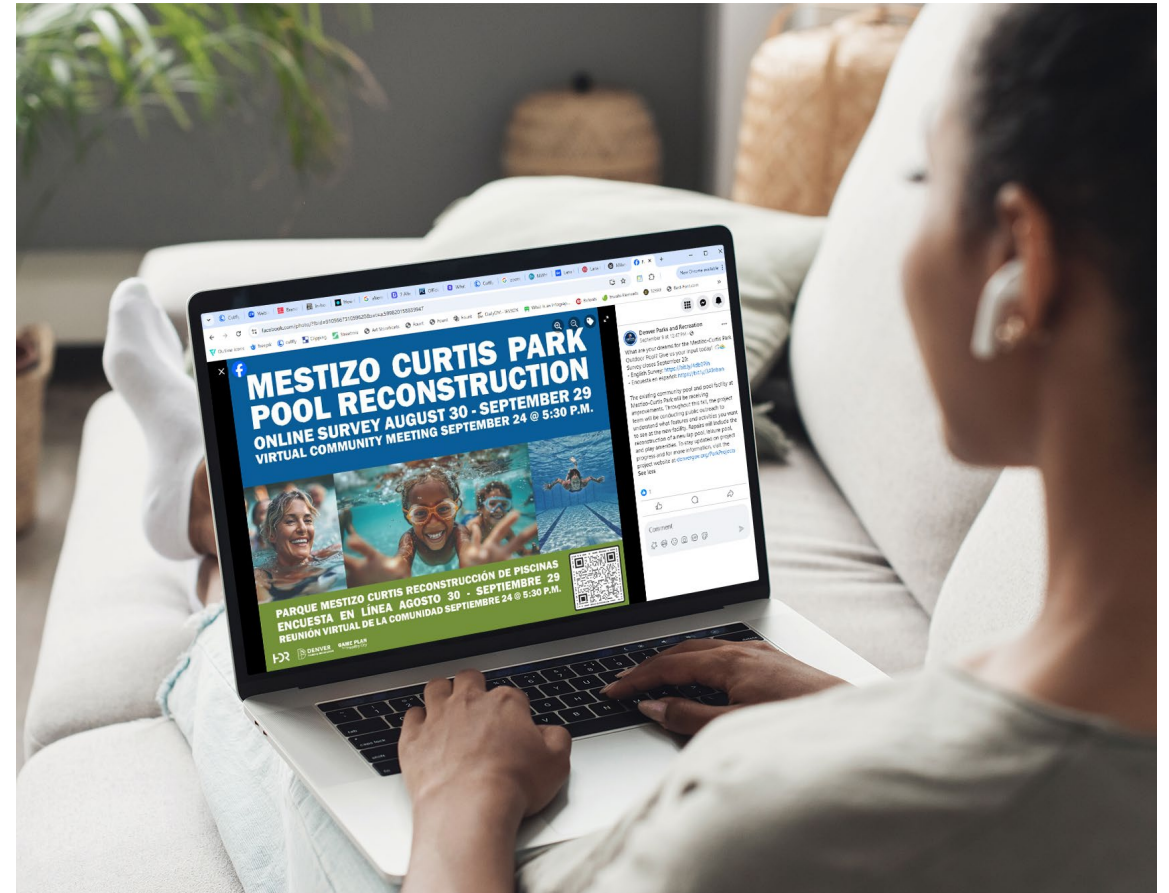

# COMMUNITY INPUT REQUEST

THE COMMUNITY WAS ASKED,  
**“WHAT ARE YOUR DREAMS  
FOR THE MESTIZO-CURTIS PARK OUTDOOR POOL?”**

This fall, we engaged the community with a survey and a virtual community meeting to gather input and feedback on the upcoming improvements to the Mestizo-Curtis Park Outdoor Pool and facility. Outreach efforts aimed to understand the features and activities residents would like to see in the new facility, which will include a reconstructed lap pool, leisure pool, and play amenities, as well as a new bathhouse to replace the existing one.



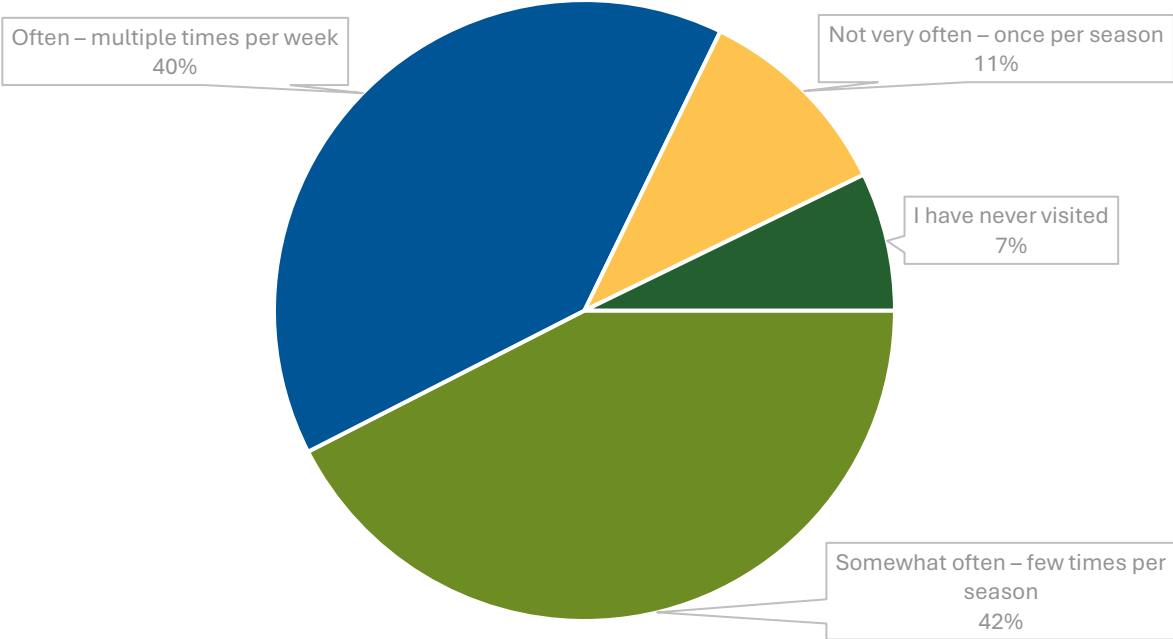
# VERIFICATION OF SURVEY RESPONSE INTEGRITY

Verification of the survey responses have been thoroughly vetted by IP addresses to ensure that no individuals submitted multiple surveys from the same computer. Each response was tracked using a unique Submission ID, resulting in a total of **653 recorded survey responses**. The data is consistent with this count, although some variations may occur due to multi-selection options or score/ranking questions.

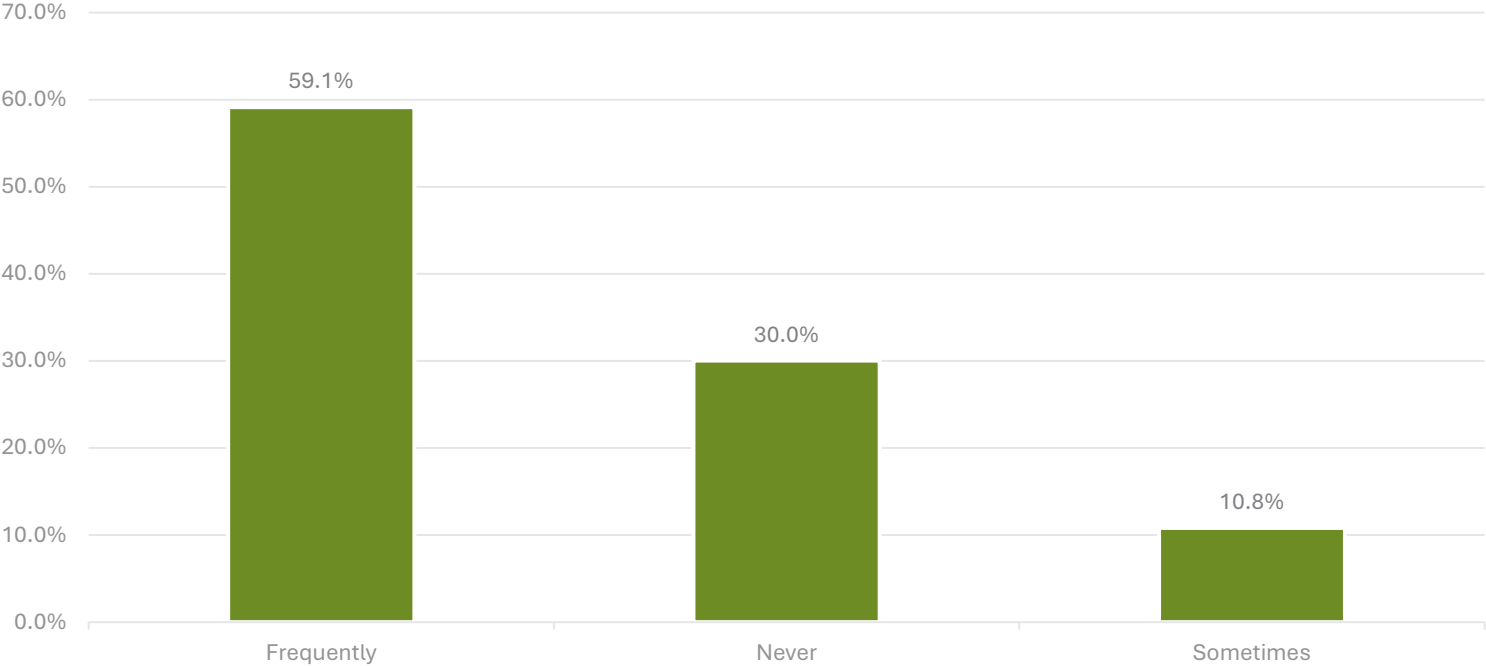
## HOW OFTEN HAVE YOU VISITED MESTIZO-CURTIS PARK POOL IN THE PAST SUMMERS?

- 4** ■ I have never visited

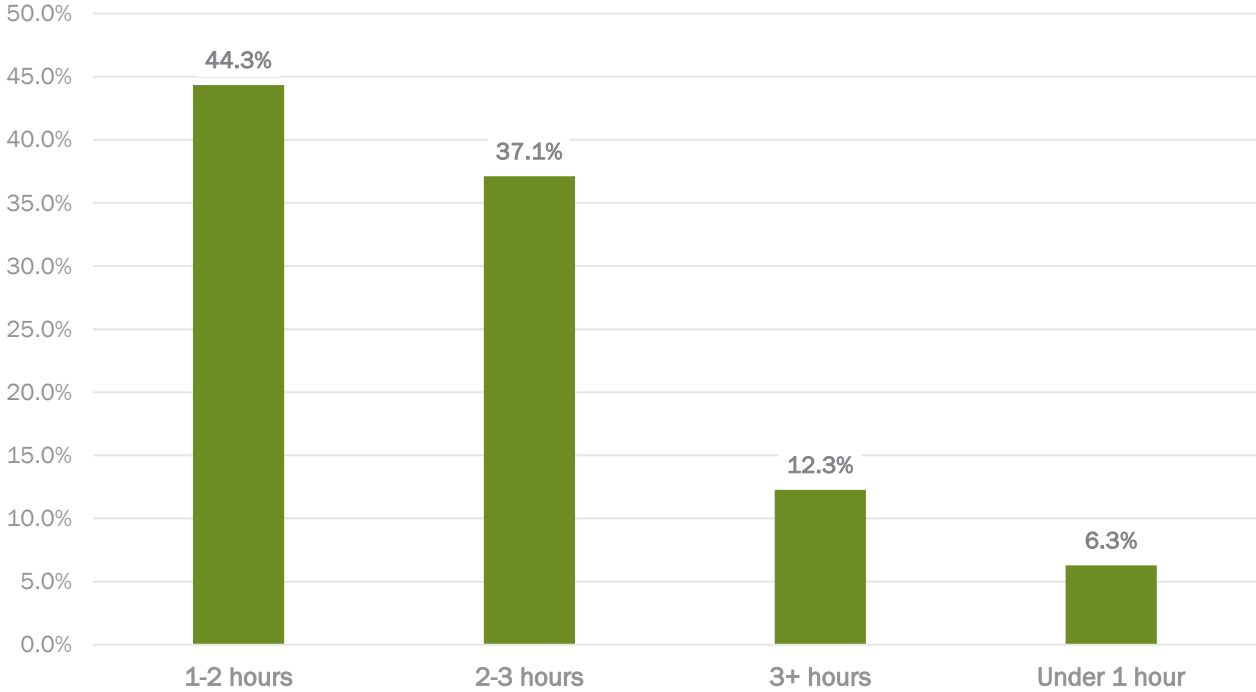

## DO YOU BRING CHILDREN TO VISIT THE POOL?



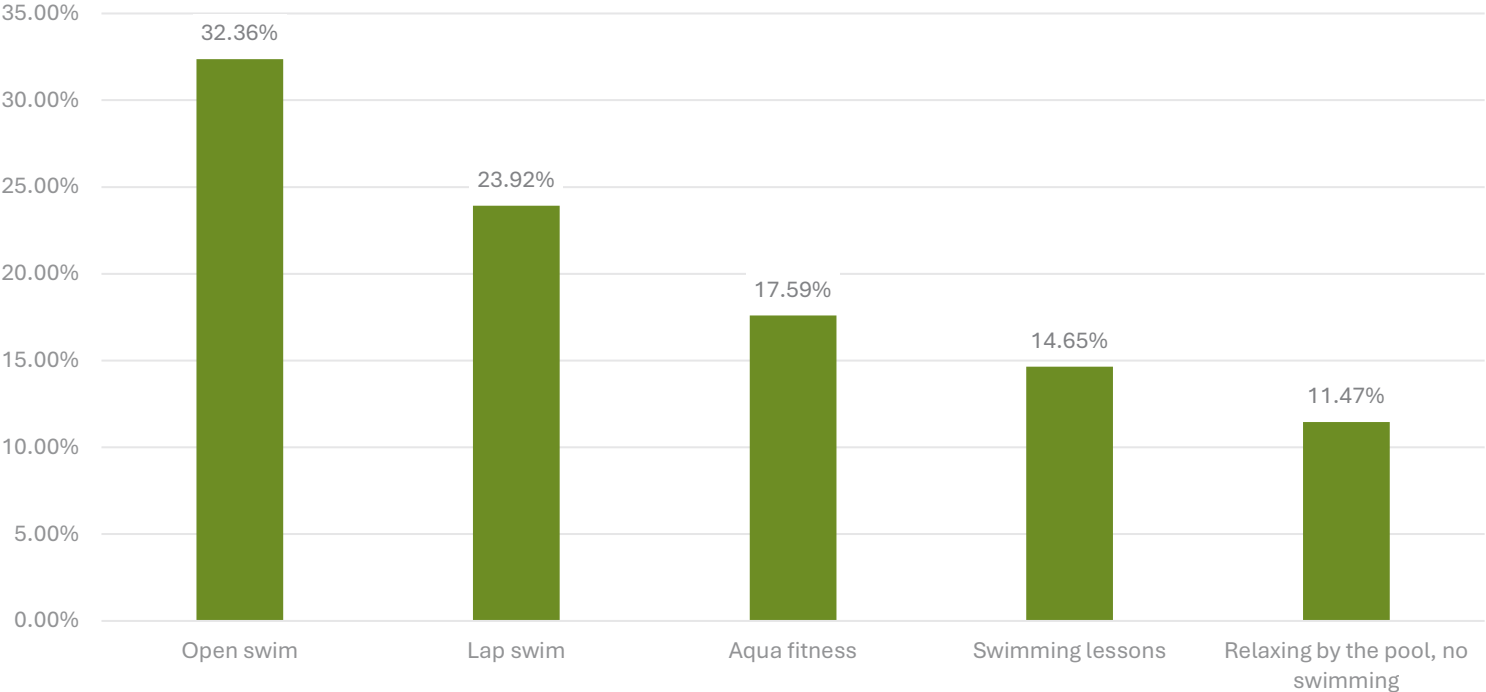

## WHEN VISITING THE POOL, HOW LONG DO YOU USUALLY STAY?



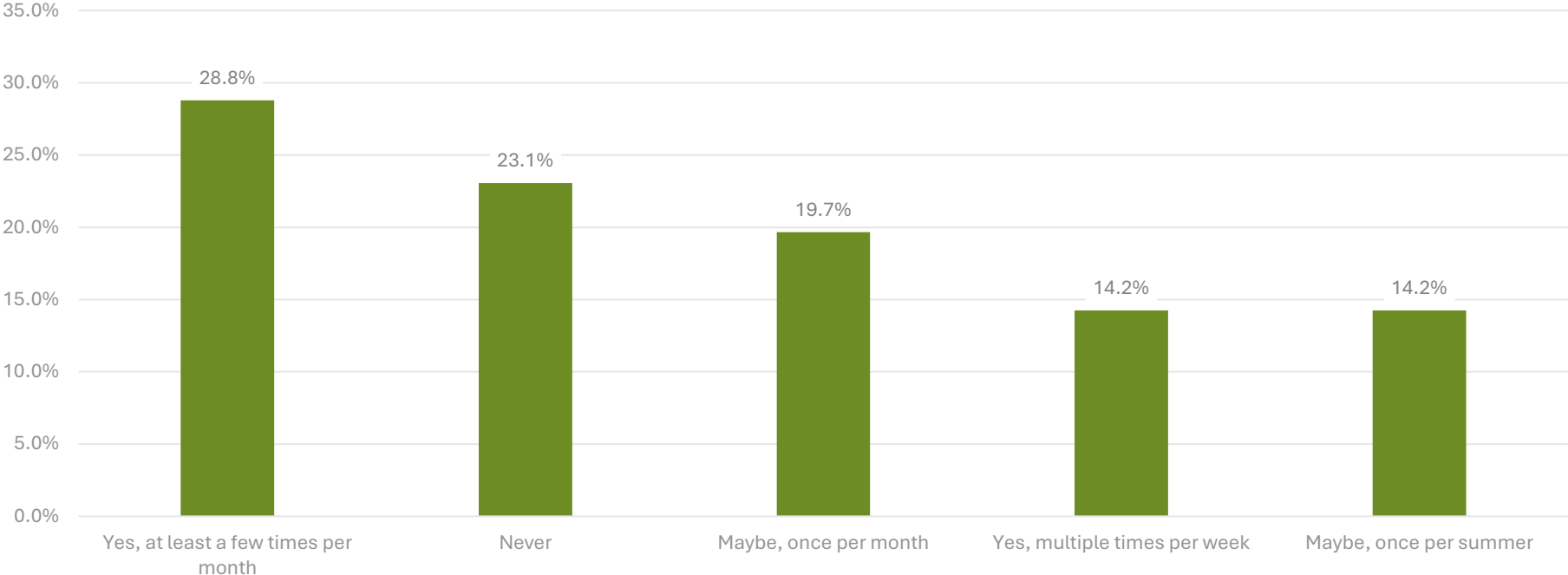

**RATE THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES THAT YOU TYPICALLY ENJOY THE MOST AT THE POOL.**



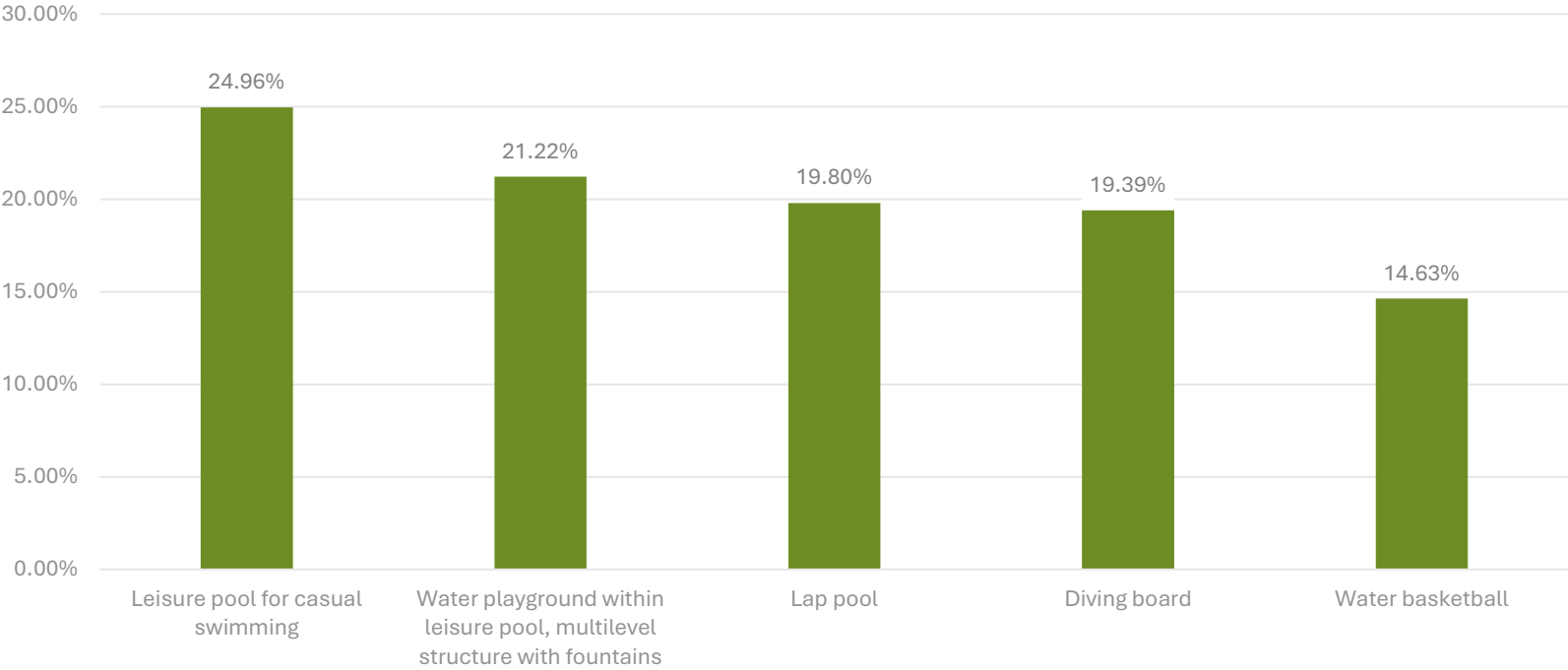

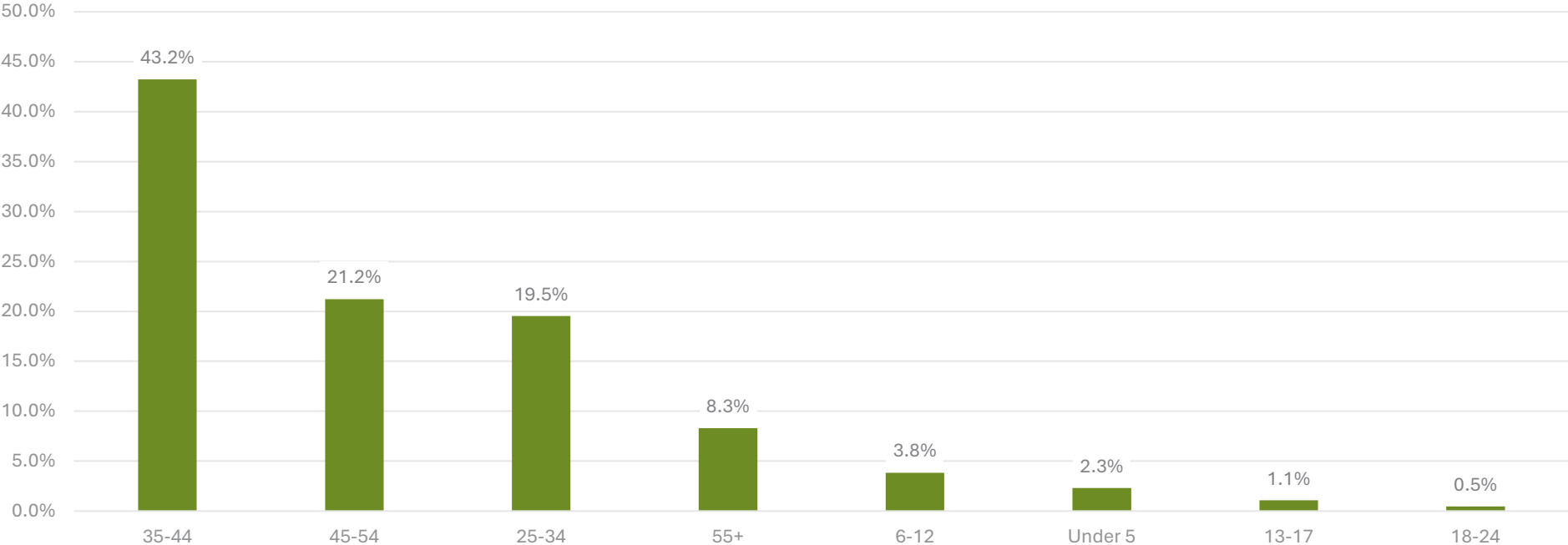
## THE FEEDBACK REVEALS

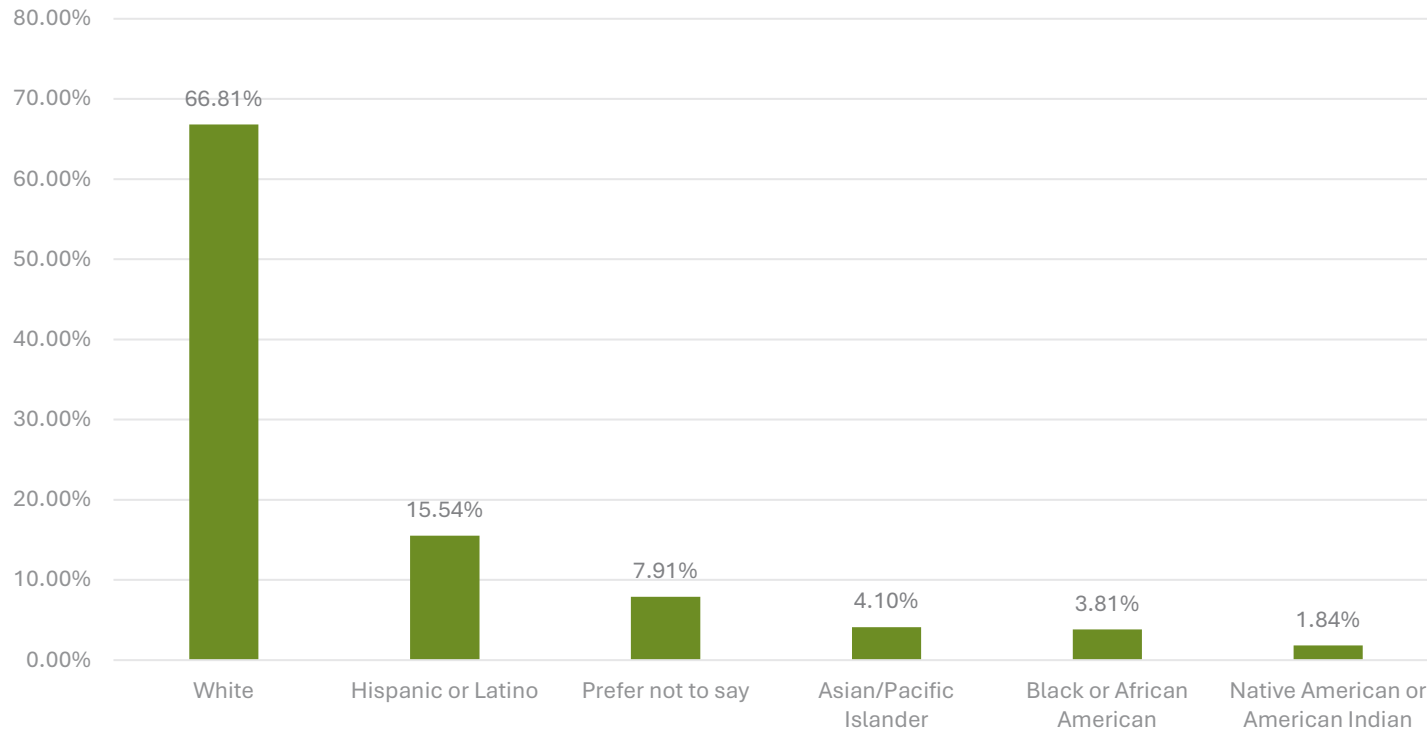

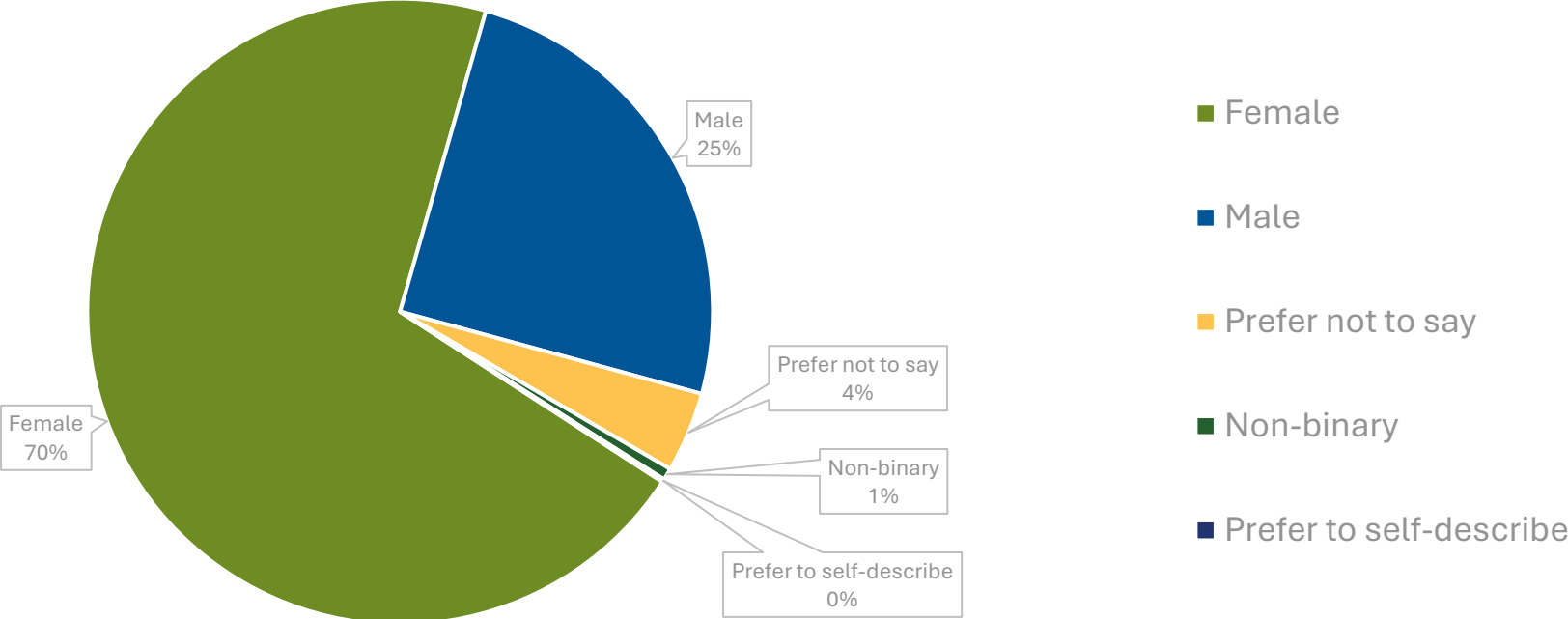

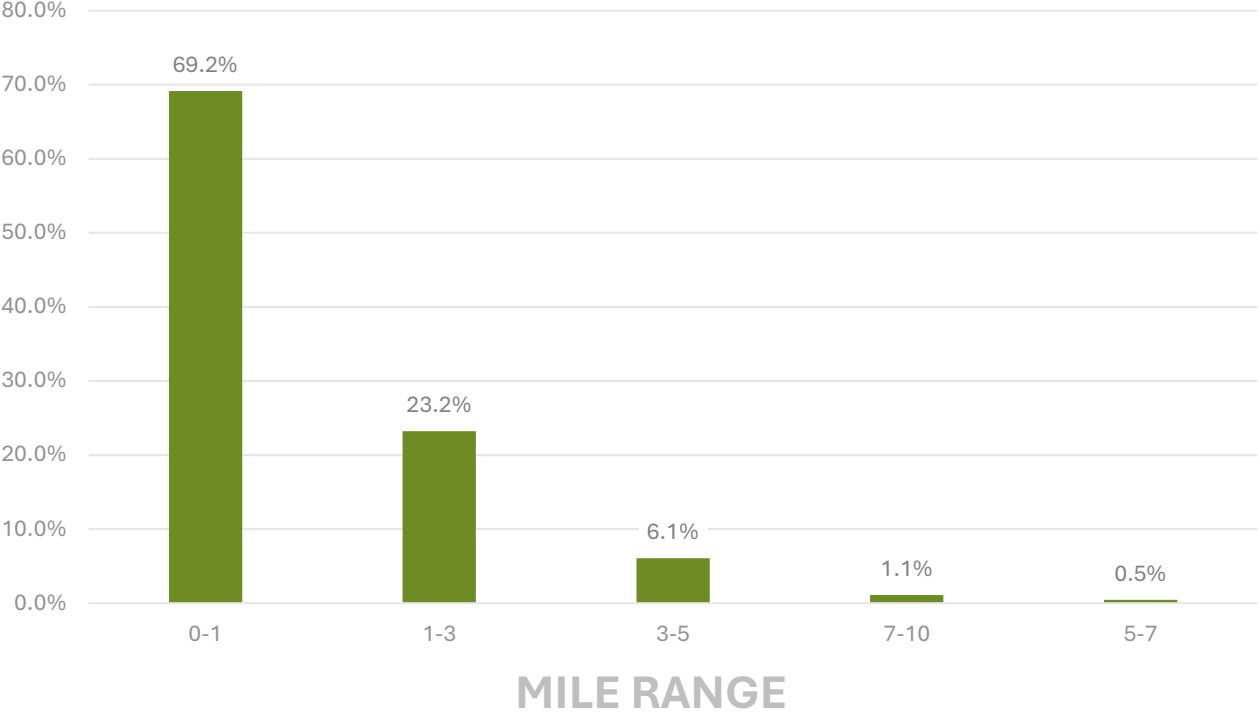

# COMMUNITY INPUT REQUEST

During the virtual community meeting, attendees were asked a series of questions to gather input and feedback on the upcoming improvements to the Mestizo-Curtis Park Outdoor Pool and facility. Outreach efforts aimed to understand the features and activities residents would like to see in the new facility.



# WHAT DID WE HEAR?

At the beginning of the meeting

**70%**

of participants provided insight they had already completed the online survey.

- **48%** of participants live less than half a mile from the pool.
- Participants were most likely to visit the pool **a few times per season.**
- **53%** of participants do **not** bring children to the pool.
- Pool users **stay between 1-2 hours** at the pool.
- **Open swim** and **lap swim** ranked **highest** during the call for favorite activities.
- **47%** of participants would like scheduled group activities/exercise classes at the pool.

# WHAT DID WE HEAR?

A majority of participants during the meeting selected **Element A** as the top choice, a 50-meter Olympic-sized lap pool and leisure pool with fewer features.
