

Special Occasion Permits in Parks

Special Occasions are private, by invitation only events. Prior to the reservation request being accepted, Park Permit Staff will review for feasibility. Please review the alcohol [policy](#) and [requirements](#) for permits with alcohol.

Special Occasion permits are allowed at many parks, the parks below are some of our most popular, and parks with an asterisk have flower gardens. Flower gardens are typically in bloom early May to October (weather permitting; dates are not guaranteed).
