General Information

The Accessible Parking Sign Program manages requests for new or removal of accessible parking signs. Parking enforcement is managed by Right-of-Way Enforcement (ROWE).

Accessible parking signs may be installed on the right-of-way for residents, businesses and multi-family properties that meet program criteria. Following proper application and documentation submission, you will be notified if your request was approved or denied, up to two weeks for response. If your request is approved, it takes at least 45 business days before the sign may be installed.
