Issue committees. Once the issue committee is formed, it must file regular reports. See D.R.M.C. § 15-35(c).

Note: The next coordinated election will be on November 7, 2023.

Please Note:

Major Contributions. The committee’s treasurer shall file a report if the committee receives any contribution or contribution in-kind of \$500 or more within the six (6) days immediately before the election. Such report shall be filed no later than 48 hours after receipt. D.R.M.C. Article III, § 15-35(f)

Reports must be filed no later than 11:59 p.m. MT on the due date to be considered a timely submission. See D.R.M.C. § 15-36(b).

- * If a reporting day falls on a weekend, legal holiday, or a City and County of Denver furlough day, the report shall be filed by the next business day. If a reporting day falls on a day when the city is fully or partially closed for business, then the report shall be filed in accordance with any and all rules or policies designated by the clerk and recorder. See D.R.M.C. § 15-35(i).
 - This provision does not apply to Major Contributor, Independent Expenditure, and Electioneering Communication Reports. See D.R.M.C. §§ 15-35(f) and 15-35.5(a).

Note: The next regularly scheduled general municipal election will be on April 4, 2023. If necessary, a runoff election will be held on June 6, 2023. All open candidate, political action committees, and small donor committees must file Pre- and Post-Election Runoff reports, even candidates who did not advance to the runoff stage or who won their election outright in the April election.
