#### Brief project description

Denver Parks and Recreation will implement a 9.5-acre landscape transformation. The project includes a complete irrigation system replacement, separate irrigation zones for trees, the conversion of non-native bluegrass to native prairie, and existing memorial garden improvements. This project is estimated to save close to 3 million gallons of water annually, support native wildlife, and provide users with a uniquely Denver park experience.
